

CPL/IRSEP/MEP/IRMEP

CPL/IRSEP/MEP/IRMEP Modular is a combination of modular training courses. The course consists of the following modules: the Single Engine Instrument Rating IR/SP/SE, the Multi Engine Class Rating MEP, the Commercial Pilot License CPL and the Performance Based Navigation (PBN). After passing CPL, IR(A)/SP/SE and PBN skill tests the student continues with the Multi Engine Instrument Rating IR/SP/ME. The duration of the course can vary from 3 to 4 months.

Pre-Entry Requirements

- ✓ Pass the Pre-Entry Assessment
- Private Pilot License (PPL) with Night Qualification (NIT) endorsed
- ✓ EASA Medical (class 1) Certificate
- Provide us the <u>original</u> EASA ATP Theoretical Completion Certificate
- ✓ Have at least 160 hours flight time, of which at least 100 hours as Pilot-in-Command, including 50 hours cross country as Pilot-in-Command and one cross country trip 300 NM with two stops at aerodromes different from the base aerodrome.

The Theoretical Training: The theoretical training course comprises of 8 hrs of ground school for the PBN.

The Flight Training: The flight training course comprises of a total of 80 hrs. Of those 25 hrs are conducted on single engine piston airplanes (SEP), 13 hrs on multi engine piston airplanes (MEP) and 38 hrs on an FNPT II flight simulator, including 21 VFR hrs and 55 IFR hrs. The flight training course commences with the Single Engine Instrument Rating (FNPT II: 35 hrs, SEP: 15 hrs) and PBN (A320 SIM: 4 hrs) and this phase of training is completed with the IR/SE Skill and PBN tests. Then, the student proceeds to the Multi Engine Class Rating (MEP: 6 hrs), the Commercial Pilot License (SEP: 10 hrs, MEP: 5 hrs) and the training is completed with the Multi Engine Instrument Rating (FNPT II: 3 hrs and MEP: 2 hrs).
