

Dear applicant,

We want to thank you for choosing Global Aviation and we assure you that you will have a creative and pleasant stay in Greece.

The purpose of this letter is to assist you in getting the Student Visa (Type D). Below, you will find a list of documents that you have to collect and submit to the Greek Embassy or Consulate in your country or in the country of your residence.

- 1. A fully completed and signed application form for a long-stay visa, accompanied by one recent photograph in color of the applicant, which must meet the relevant specifications laid down by ICAO (Full face, 3X4 cm. light colored background).
- 2. A passport or other travel document recognized by Greece, with a validity which must exceed by three months the ending date of the visa length, with at least two blank pages, and issued within the previous ten years.
- 3. Biometrics if needed, (full face & finger prints).
- 4. Full copy of the data page and used pages of the passport.
- 5. Proof that the applicant or his sponsor are in possession of sufficient financial means to pay for the course and support his stay in Greece (i.e. last six months statement of bank account with satisfactory movement and balance, letter of employment stating the position, monthly salary and date of employment etc.). A Curriculum Vitae of the applicant or his sponsor is mandatory.
- 6. A copy of the applicant's criminal record issued by the Police of his/her country, certifying the applicant's criminal status. A copy of the applicant's criminal record issued by their Embassy may be also required, if the applicant is staying in another country rather than his/her birth country for more than a year.
- 7. A medical certificate by a recognized state or private organization, certifying that the applicant is free of any disease capable of putting public health at risk, according to the international provisions and the World Health Organization (plague, cholera, yellow fever, tuberculosis), as well as of other contagious, infectious or parasitic diseases which would require the adoption of public health protection measures.
- 8. Travel medical insurance valid for a period of no less than the length of the visa, covering any expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment.
- 9. Application Fee

Below is a list of documents that the Academy will send you in order to submit them also to the Greek Embassy or Consulate.

- 1. The Academy's Certificate of Approval
- 2. Certificate of Training Course, Period and Beginning of the Course
- 3. Certificate of Acceptance

The application must be submitted at least 6 months prior of the beginning of the course.

With the completion of the Greek Security Checks, and before the visa issuance, the applicant deposits the first instalment, according to his/her contract with the Academy, and the Academy sends to the applicant the Payment Certificate and Receipt for the purpose of submitting them to the Greek Consulate. Only in this case, the applicant can get the Type D visa.
